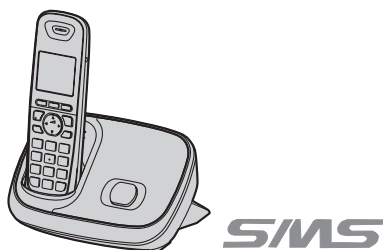

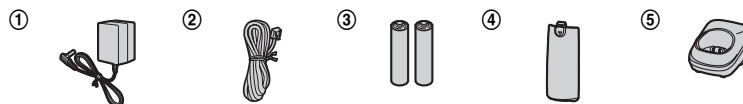

## Important Information

### For your safety

To prevent severe injury and loss of life/property, read this section carefully before using the product to ensure proper and safe operation of your product.

#### WARNING

##### Power connection

- Use only the power source marked on the product.
- Do not overload power outlets and extension cords. This can result in the risk of fire or electric shock.
- Completely insert the AC adaptor/power plug into the power outlet. Failure to do so may cause electric shock and/or excessive heat resulting in a fire.
- Regularly remove any dust, etc. from the AC adaptor/power plug by pulling it from the power outlet, then wiping with a dry cloth. Accumulated dust may cause an insulation defect from moisture, etc. resulting in a fire.
- Unplug the product from power outlets if it emits smoke, an abnormal smell, or makes an unusual noise. These conditions can cause fire or electric shock. Confirm that smoke has stopped emitting and contact an authorised service centre.
- Unplug from power outlets and never touch the inside of the product if its casing has been broken open.
- Never touch the plug with wet hands. Danger of electric shock exists.

##### Installation

- To prevent the risk of fire or electrical shock, do not expose the product to rain or any type of moisture.
- Do not place or use this product near automatically controlled devices such as automatic doors and fire alarms. Radio waves emitted from this product may cause such devices to malfunction resulting in an accident.
- Do not allow the AC adaptor or telephone line cord to be excessively pulled, bent or placed under heavy objects.

##### Operating safeguards

- Unplug the product from power outlets before cleaning. Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners.

#### Medical

- Never install telephone wiring during an electrical storm.

- This product is unable to make calls when:
  - the handset batteries need recharging or have failed.
  - there is a power failure.
  - the key lock feature is turned on.

#### Battery

- We recommend using the batteries noted on 4. oldal. **USE ONLY rechargeable Ni-MH batteries AAA (R03) size.**
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not open or mutilate the batteries. Released electrolyte from the batteries is corrosive and may cause burns or injury to the eyes or skin. The electrolyte is toxic and may be harmful if swallowed.
- Exercise care when handling the batteries. Do not allow conductive materials such as rings, bracelets, or keys to touch the batteries, otherwise a short circuit may cause the batteries

and/or the conductive material to overheat and cause burns.

- Charge the batteries provided with or identified for use with this product only, in accordance with the instructions and limitations specified in this manual.
- Only use a compatible base unit (or charger) to charge the batteries. Do not tamper with the base unit (or charger). Failure to follow these instructions may cause the batteries to swell or explode.

### Important safety instructions

When using your product, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, including the following:

1. Do not use this product near water for example, near a bathtub, washbowl, kitchen sink, or laundry tub, in a wet basement or near a swimming pool.
2. Avoid using a telephone (other than a cordless type) during an electrical storm. There may be a remote risk of electric shock from lightning.
3. Do not use the telephone to report a gas leak in the vicinity of the leak.

### For best performance

#### Base unit location/avoiding noise

The base unit and other compatible Panasonic units use radio waves to communicate with each other.

- For maximum coverage and noise-free communications, place your base unit:
  - at a convenient, high, and central location with no obstructions between the handset and base unit in an indoor environment.
  - away from electronic appliances such as TVs, radios, personal computers, wireless devices, or other phones.
  - facing away from radio frequency transmitters, such as external antennas of mobile phone cell stations. (Avoid putting the base unit on a bay window or near a window.)

- Coverage and voice quality depends on the local environmental conditions.
- If the reception for a base unit location is not satisfactory, move the base unit to another location for better reception.

#### Environment

- Keep the product away from electrical noise generating devices, such as fluorescent lamps and motors.
- The product should be kept free from excessive smoke, dust, high temperature, and vibration.
- The product should not be exposed to direct sunlight.
- Do not place heavy objects on top of the product.
- When you leave the product unused for a long period of time, unplug the product from the power outlet.

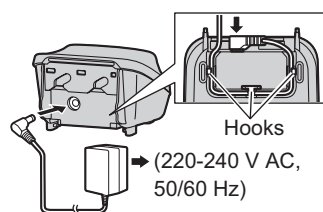
- Use only the supplied Panasonic AC adaptor PQLV219CE.

#### ■ Base unit



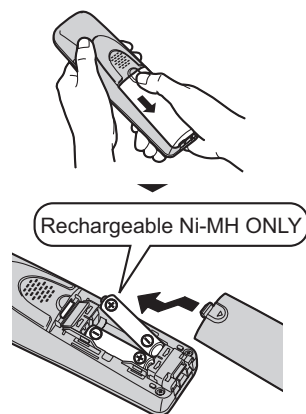

### Battery installation

- USE ONLY Ni-MH batteries AAA (R03) size.
- Do NOT use Alkaline/Manganese/Ni-Cd batteries.
- Confirm correct polarities ( $\oplus$ ,  $\ominus$ ).

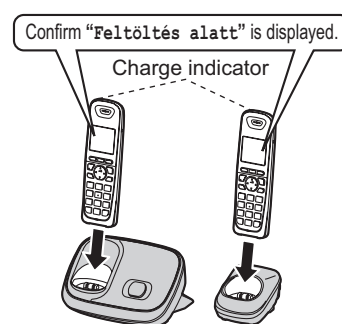


- When the language selection is displayed, see 12. oldal.

### Battery charge

Charge for about 7 hours.

- When the batteries are fully charged, the charge indicator goes off and "Töltés kész" is displayed.





**Getting Started****Note when setting up****Note for connections**

- The AC adaptor must remain connected at all times. (It is normal for the adaptor to feel warm during use.)
- The AC adaptor should be connected to a vertically oriented or floor-mounted AC outlet. Do not connect the AC adaptor to a ceiling-mounted AC outlet, as the weight of the adaptor may cause it to become disconnected.

**During a power failure**

The unit will not work during a power failure. We recommend connecting a corded-type telephone (without AC adaptor) to the same telephone line or to the same telephone line jack, if you have such a telephone jack in your house.



**Note for battery installation**



- Use the supplied rechargeable batteries. For replacement, we recommend using the Panasonic rechargeable batteries noted on 4, 5. oldal.
- Wipe the battery ends (+, -) with a dry cloth.
- Avoid touching the battery ends (+, -) or the unit contacts.

**Note for battery charge**

- It is normal for the handset to feel warm during charging.
- Clean the charge contacts of the handset, base unit, and charger with a soft and dry cloth once a month. Clean more often if the unit is exposed to grease, dust, or high humidity.

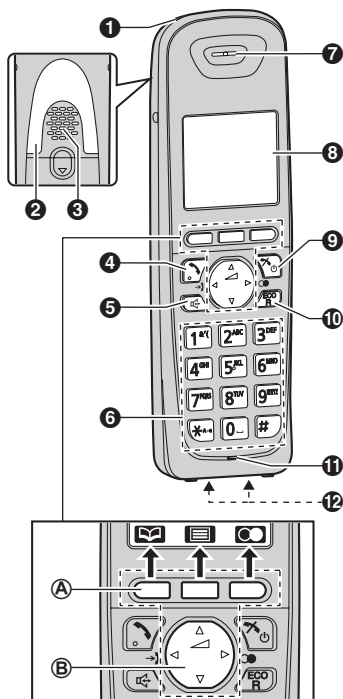
**Megjegyzés:**

- It is normal for batteries not to reach full capacity at the initial charge. Maximum battery performance is reached after a few complete cycles of charge/discharge (use).
- Actual battery performance depends on usage and ambient environment.
- Even after the handset is fully charged, the handset can be left on the base unit or charger without any ill effect on the batteries.
- The battery level may not be displayed correctly after you replace the batteries. In this case, place the handset on the base unit or charger and let it charge for at least 7 hours.

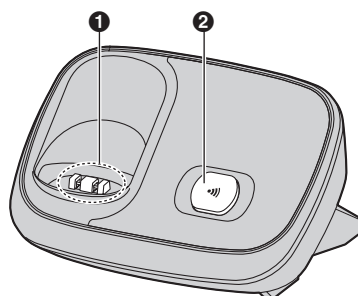

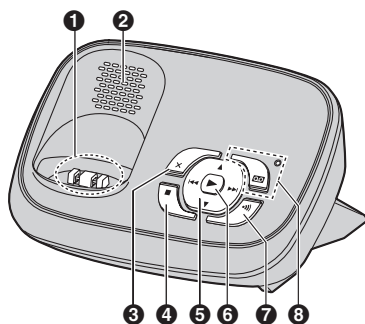

## Turning the power on/off

Press for about 1 second.

### Power off

Press for about 2 seconds.

**Megjegyzés:**

- To correct a digit, press [**↶**] or [**↷**] to move the cursor to the digit, then make the correction.
- The date and time may be incorrect after a power failure. In this case, set the date and time again.

- If you set the repeater mode to "**BE**" (28. oldal):
  - One touch eco mode is cancelled.
  - "**Takarékos beállítás**" is not shown in the display menu (21. oldal).

## One touch eco mode

When the handset is on the base unit, the base unit transmission power is reduced up to 99.9% if only one handset is registered. Even when the handset is not on the base unit or several handsets are registered, the base unit transmission power in standby mode can be reduced up to 90% by activating one touch eco mode.

You can turn on/off one touch eco mode by just pressing [**ECO/R**]. The default setting is "**Normál**".

- When the one touch eco mode is on: "**Alacsony**" is temporarily displayed and **ECO** is shown on the handset display instead of **Y**.
- When the one touch eco mode is off: "**Normál**" is temporarily displayed and **ECO** goes off from the handset display.

**Megjegyzés:**

- When there is another cordless phone nearby and it is in use, the base unit transmission power may not be reduced.
- Activating one touch eco mode reduces the range of the base unit in standby mode.

## Making/Answering Calls

### Making calls

- 1 Lift the handset and dial the phone number.
  - To correct a digit, press **C**.
- 2 Press **[↶]** or **[↷]**.
- 3 When you finish talking, press **[⏏]** or place the handset on the base unit or charger.

#### Using the speakerphone

- 1 Dial the phone number and press **[☎]**.
  - Speak alternately with the other party.
- 2 When you finish talking, press **[⏏]**.

#### Megjegyzés:

- For best performance, use the speakerphone in a quiet environment.
- To switch back to the receiver, press **[↶]**.

#### Adjusting the receiver or speaker volume

Press **[▲]** or **[▼]** repeatedly while talking.

#### Making a call using the redial list

The last 10 phone numbers dialed are stored in the redial list (each 24 digits max.).

- 1 **[☎]** or **[▶] (●)**
- 2 **[▼]/[▲]**: Select the desired phone number.
- 3 **[↶]**

#### Erasing a number in the redial list

- 1 **[☎]** or **[▶] (●)**
- 2 **[▼]/[▲]**: Select the desired phone number. → **[X]**
- 3 **[▼]/[▲]**: "IGEN" → **OK** → **[⏏]**

#### Pause (for PBX/long distance service users)

A pause is sometimes required when making calls using a PBX or long distance service. When storing a calling card access number and/or PIN in the phonebook, a pause is also needed (17. oldal).

**Példa:** If you need to dial the line access number "0" when making outside calls with a PBX:

- 1 **[0] → P**
- 2 Dial the phone number. → **[↶]**

#### Megjegyzés:

- A 3 second pause is inserted each time **P** is pressed. Repeat as needed to create longer pauses.

### Answering calls

When a call is being received, the ringer indicator flashes rapidly.

- 1 Lift the handset and press **[↶]** or **[☎]** when the unit rings.
  - You can also answer the call by pressing any dial key from **[0]** to **[9]**, **[\*]**, or **#**. (Any key answer feature)
- 2 When you finish talking, press **[⏏]** or place the handset on the base unit or charger.

#### Auto talk

You can answer calls simply by lifting the handset off the base unit or charger. You do not need to press **[↶]**. To turn this feature on, see 22. oldal.

#### Adjusting the handset ringer volume

Press **[▲]** or **[▼]** repeatedly to select the desired volume while the handset is ringing for an incoming call.

#### Megjegyzés:

- You can also program the handset ringer volume beforehand (22. oldal).

#### Temporary handset ringer off






While the handset is ringing for a call, you can turn the ringer off temporarily by pressing **[M]**.

## Making/Answering Calls

### Useful features during a call

#### Hold

This feature allows you to put an outside call on hold.




- 1 Press  during an outside call.
- 2 /: "Tartás" → **OK**
- 3 To release hold, press .
  - Another handset user can take the call by pressing .

#### Megjegyzés:

- If a call is kept on hold for more than 9 minutes, an alarm tone starts to sound and the ringer indicator flashes rapidly. After 1 additional minute on hold, the call is disconnected.
- If another phone is connected to the same line (9. oldal), you can also take the call by lifting its handset.

#### Mute

While mute is turned on, you can hear the other party, but the other party cannot hear you.

#### Recall/flash

**[ECO/R]** allows you to use the special features of your host PBX such as transferring an extension call, or accessing optional telephone services.

The answering system can answer and record calls for you when you are unavailable to answer the phone.

You can also set the unit to play a greeting message but not to record caller messages by selecting "Csak üdv." as the recording time setting (38. oldal).

#### Fontos:

- Only 1 person can access the answering system (listen to messages, record a greeting message, etc.) at a time.
- When callers leave messages, the unit records the day and time of each message. Make sure the date and time have been set correctly (12. oldal).

### Memory capacity (including your greeting message)

The total recording capacity is about 20 minutes. A maximum of 64 messages can be recorded.



Messages are recorded by your service provider/telephone company, not your telephone. When you have new messages,  is displayed on the handset if message indication service is available. Please contact your service provider/telephone company for details of this service.

#### Fontos:

- If  still remains on the display even after you have listened to new messages, turn it off by pressing and holding **[#]** for 2 seconds.
- To use the voice mail service provided by your service provider/telephone company rather than the unit's answering system, turn off the answering system (34. oldal). For details, see 38. oldal.

## Intercom/Locator

### Intercom

Intercom calls can be made between handsets.

## Useful Information

### Character entry

The dial keys are used to enter characters and numbers. Each dial key has multiple characters assigned to it. The characters that can be entered depend on the character entry mode (41. oldal).

- Press **[C]** to erase the character or number highlighted by the cursor. Press and hold **[C]** to erase all characters or numbers.
